Matthew 22:1-46

Lesson 20

Assignment for next Week — Read Matthew 23:1-39 Memory Verse — Matthew 22:37-40

Jesus being God's son was able to share with us knowledge of Heaven and God's kingdom. On several occassions the Pharisees, Scribes, Sadducees, and Herodians each tried to test Jesus. Through Christ's answers to these questions we learn more about how we should live as citizens of a nation, about some of our nature in the world to come, and about the greatest commandment in the Law.

One of the parables Jesus told was about a king who was celebrating the wedding of his son and when he had called the invited guests they refused his invitation and some even killed his servants. The king was angry with those who refused him and destroyed them and their cities and told his servants to go into the highways and invite all to come to the dinner. Truely God has invited us to a great feast and desires that we would be His. However, many men have chosen their business or work to be more important than God's and some have even went as far as to kill our Lord's servants. How tragic that one would kill those who would invite them to enjoy such a great occassion. At the feast there was one present without a wedding garment. The king had the one who had come unsuitable prepared cast into outer darkness. Let us seek to have the garment that God would desire us to have by obeying his word and will. Once again Christ repeats, "Many are called but few are chosen." Many men have heard God's word, but not all have chosen to obey. May we be those who are willing to accept God's




goodness and graciousness and seek to live for him.

Sometime later the Pharisees sent their followers along with the Herodians to test Jesus. The question they asked Jesus was whether it was lawful to give tribute to Caesar. Christ answered that they should give to Caeser the things that are Caesers and to God the things that are God's.

A while after the Herodians had asked Jesus their question the Sadducees came and asked Jesus a question concerning the resurrection. The Sadducees explained the situation of a woman who had seven husbands. The wife had married a man and when he died she had no children. It was customary when a man had died leaving no seed for his wife to marry his brother and this is what she did. This same incident happened five more times until she had been the wife of all seven brothers and died. The Sadducees wanted to know whose wife she would be in the resurrection. The Lord told the Sadducees that they did not know the scriptures. The Lord taught them that in the resurrection they are neither married or given in marraige, but they are like the angels in heaven.

Finally, a lawyer came and asked Jesus what the greatest commandment in the law was. Christ answered, that the greatest commandment was for him to love the Lord God with all his heart, soul, mind and strength. Christ told him that the second great commandment was to love one's neighbor as himself stating that upon those two commandments the whole law was hung. Today we too should love God with all our heart, soul, mind and strength. If we Love God we will do his will. Also Paul said that if we love our neighbor as our self we will fulfill the whole law. It is critical that we love our neighbor because John wrote that if we cannot love our brother whom we have seen how can we love our Heavenly
